

2026 JCC Maccabi Vaccination Policy

All athletes wishing to participate in JCC Maccabi must be up to date with the following age-appropriate vaccines recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and the Center for Disease Control (CDC).

Athletes will have to upload proof of vaccinations in CampDoc. PLEASE NOTE – there has been a shift in the required vs. recommended vaccines since 2023.

Required vaccinations are:

- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis)
- IPV (Poliovirus)
- Hib (Haemophilus influenzae type b bacteria)
- PCV 13 (Pneumococcal) vaccine or PCV 23
- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) or serologic evidence of immunity
- Varicella vaccine (Chicken Pox), or serologic or historical evidence of immunity
- Meningococcal vaccine age 11 and again at age 16(5 year interval)
- Hepatitis B if required by the state that the Games is taking place in (in order to attend public school)

Recommended, but not required:

- COVID-19 and current available booster
- Hepatitis A
- Influenza (flu)

JCC Maccabi reserves the right to update this policy at any time and without prior notice. Please see the CDC's vaccine schedule for more information.
